Trek the Mighty Mac 2019 September 20-21 Vendor Information

Hello ATV Enthusiast,

Believe it or not, the 5th Annual Trek the Mighty Mac is right around the corner! This event continues to bring ATV, ORV, and xS enthusiasts and owners from all over the Midwest for a fun-filled weekend of off-roading following a trip across the iconic Mackinac Bridge. Current registration numbers predict an increase in registrations over last year and we are in the process of bringing manufacturers on this year to offer test drives, which will be an additional draw for visitors. We are also working to include a mud run or tactical course to help make the 5th year extra special.

As in previous years, we will not be charging vending or exhibiting fees, though this may be changing soon, so take advantage of this opportunity while you can! Again, sponsor/vendor/exhibitor space will be offered on a first come first served basis, based on available space.

Here's what you need to know:

- Vending space is available indoors and outdoors. Outdoor space is available in Mackinaw City at the staging area, Darrow's Gravel Pit (there is no address, but head West on Central Ave. in Mackinaw City, past the high school, and you will find the area marked on your left). This location is available all day on Friday, September 20th only.
- Indoor and outdoor vending space is available at Little Bear East (located at 275 Marquette St. in St. Ignace) on Saturday, September 21 from 11 AM to 2 PM only. You are welcome to vend in both locations on both days.
- Space will be provided in 10x10 ft. increments. When you express interest, we will let you know the maximum amount of space we can provide for you, based on your space request.
- You will need to bring your own table, chairs, and any other props. Please also bring carts or wagons; some will be available but there are only a few and they are in high demand.
- Outdoor vender set up on Friday in Mackinaw City will be open from 10 AM to 12 PM. If you arrive after 12 PM, we cannot guarantee your space. Teardown is up to you; registration will be from 12 PM to 10 PM. Many people come first thing after registration opens. The second largest rush is in the late afternoon, about 5-7 PM.
- Indoor and outdoor vendor set up At Little Bear East is on Saturday in St. Ignace from 9 AM to 10:30 AM. NO indoor vendors will be permitted to set up after 10:30, however outdoor vendors can setup once they arrive, especially if participating in crossing.
